The pursuit was initiated at the Initially, we were unable to get on the air, due to a citywide broadcast that was taking place. We were finally able to request the air as we were approaching the block of We were given the air to broadcast by the dispatcher, at which time I was able to give our location, and direction of travel. The dispatcher responded and I was told to continue my broadcast. As other

squads responded to our chase, I was unable to get on the air. The radio continually beeped as I tried to key the microphone. The raido would also emit a steady beep as I attempted to continue our broadcast.
