Narrative: When I call the dispatcher she states they cannot hear us. During a foot chase you cannot change locations to the chase, because the squad in the chase needs the air. If you broadcast a location change and the officer in pursuit tries to broadcast they set the beeps and cannot give their location. I had an active register and could not get on the air because another officer was talking to dispatch. It is a huge officer safety issue that you cannot interrupt a broadcast. I have witnessed officer batteries fall off the radio, because of where the release lever is. We have asked supervisors to staff us 2 man in squad cars in case of a serious incident were to occur. I have been written up for non compliance by the dispatcher because they cannot hear me, and think I am not calling them

back. The radios also make a clicking sound when officers are broadcasting. This makes it hard to hard to hear their location on traffic sops, and to drive by to check on their safety. There has also been several times that no on is broadcasting and I receive the beeps denying me to talk to the dispatcher. These problems happen everyday to almost every officer on a daily basis.
