Narrative:	This report was writen by Sgt. Todd G. LEWAN, assigned to district 4, late shift. All of the below radio transmissions were attempted outside on the sidewalk or street. On 07/25/2009 @ 1:03am. (CAD# 092060127), Squad 4369 P.O. BOEHM and P.O. GAETH were dispatched to a subject wiht a gun at Squad 4462 (Veh# 219), P.O. KOWALIK (radio# 8040) and P.O. WAGNER (radio# 8022) were conducting a saturation patrol in the area due to homicides and shootings in the area. P.O. WAGNER heard Squad 4469 get dispatched over his radio. He parked the squad in the alley nearby and approached on foot and heard a female voice yelling and screaming. He observed and the called identified a white car leaving the area as being	

involved. P.O. WAGNER attempted to use his portable radio to broadcast this information but only heard three beeps when he keyed the microphone. Onice inside the squad car he was able to broadcast that a white car was leaving. The portable radio continued the perform the same way until Squad 4462 drove past District 4.
