Narrative:	<p>I WAS INSIDE DISTRICT TWO STATION WHEN I REALIZED MY HAND HELD RADIO WAS NOT RECEIVING. FOR EVERY 5 SECONDS OR SO OF RADIO TRAFFIC HEARD OVER NEARBY ANALOG UNITS, I HEARD A FRACTION OF A SECOND OF GARBLED AUDIO. IT DIDNT MATTER WHAT CHANNEL THE RADIO WAS TURNED TO, NOR DID MY LOCATION WITHIN STATION SEEM TO MATTER. THE MALFUNCTION PERSISTED WHEN I WAS NO LONGER IN THE AREA OF THE HANDHELD UNITS. I TURNED THE RADIO OFF AND BACK ON AGAIN, BUT THE PROBLEM DID NOT RESOLVE. DURING THE PERIOD OF THIS MALFUNCTION, THE READOUT OF THE RADIO KEPT FLASHING "PLEASE LOGIN". THE RADIO, WHICH HAD BEEN SET TO CHANNEL 14 WITH A SCAN TO</p>

CHANNEL 8, DID INDICATE THAT IT WAS STILL SCANNING, BUT NO AUDIO CAME OVER THE SPEAKER. AFTER TURNING THE UNIT OFF, AND RIDING TO NTF HEADQUARTERS TO REPLACE THE UNIT, WHICH WAS APPROX 10 MINUTES, IT FUNCTIONED PROPERLY AGAIN WHEN I TURNED IT ON TO RECHECK IT.
