 I attempted to notify the dispatcher that we responded and setting up containment. I keyed the mic in the squad several times and each time I could not transmit and received a triple beeping tone. After several attempts I looked at the radio head and saw that PD02 had an open mic and would not allow me to transmit. After that cleared from the screen, I tried to transmit again, but received the familiar three beeps again. I heard a supervisor call out a subject matching the description and I made the stop. Approximately 5 minutes later, I was able to advise dispatch of the stop. I had to reposition my squad while maintaining containment at

Shortly after that, a city wide broadcast was done (before the foot pursuit was called by the supervisor) while there were officers on foot checking for the suspect.
