Narrative:	On Wednesday, April 7, 2010 at approximately 5:50pm, squads in District 1 and 6, while operating on Channel 3, were unable to communicate with a dispatcher for approximately 7 minutes.
	Squads were able to hear each other, but no response was being received from the dispatcher. I had to get out a pad of paper and act as the dispatcher to record my squads' locations for traffic stops and FIs.
	I called 7472 and was advised after the dispatcher came on the air that there

was no apparent problem with the channel.

Seven minutes is a long time in the "police world" and being unable to communicate with a dispatcher for this length of time could have very serious consequences.

I highly doubt that this was user error (i.e. no dispatcher monitoring the channel). This would appear to be a radio system failure.
