Narrative:	<p>Radio trouble was in both Our squad that day was a spare that had no functioning mobile radio system (it had the old Motorola analog radio).</p> <p>On Fri 04-23-10, PO Milton STUBBS and I left the DA's office at about 4:30pm. We were unable to transmit on either hand held radio to inform the dispatcher of our location change to D3 to secure. Both hand held displays showed that the batteries were almost fully charged. Where the signal bars on the display are usually located, there were none. However, the symbol after them had a diagonal line across it. We also were unable to hear any</p>

transmissions by the dispatcher or other squads. We attempted to get on the air every block but were unsuccessful. As I pulled up to to exchange batteries and/or radios, the hand helds began to receive service. Upon confirming that the hand helds were then capable of transmitting, we notified the dispatcher (at about 4:34pm) that we were heading in to D3 to secure.
