I asked both D7 and D4 dispatchers if they had those channels patched and they stated no. When I turned on my portable radio, it displayed that PD03 (My position) was keying up the radio on both channels. My radio console didn't show that it was transmitting on either channel. Several other channels also reported that PD03 was showing transmitting on thier channels. I kept patching & unpatching the channels which didn't seem to help. 7472 Sergeant Peerenboom contacted the radio shop who stated to reboot the radio console.

5/6 Sgt Doug Wiorek, OMAP (working replacement in D6)- Additional comment concerning: This incident locked up channel 3 for 7-8 minutes. A few attempts were made at transmitting by someone, but there were intelligible and random in nature.
