Narrative: (Channel 10 and Channel 12) Intermittently throughout the night at various locations northeast of N 60th and W Capitol Ave., the portable unit would be beeping every few seconds as if the battery was low. The battery was at full charge. A different battery was put in and it still beeped every few seconds. Finally at about 10:30 PM while at an assignment in the I had enough. The unit would receive about 10% of the dispatcher's broadcasts; other officers with portable units were in the area and they were receiving just fine. The shoulder mic appeared to be properly connected. I attempted to call the dispatcher and got a low tone beep then a high pitched beep. I tried 3 more times to call the dispatcher with the portable

radio then gave up. I used the squad radio to inform dispatch we would be enroute to D7 to get a new handheld radio. Unit was placed with an orange sticker affixed on the D7 sergeants office desk.
