As requested, here are answers to the questions you asked last week:

- -- Estimated delivery date of yellow, FM-approved portables is late August. This is based on parallel efforts to ramp up production of yellow covers and receive the required quantity, and obtain FM and FCC approval. I just left a meeting regarding the FM approval plan, and what can/will be done to obtain it. Fortunately, what we are experiencing with the FM approval is typical, so our Product people have reasonable confidence that they will work through the flagged issues over the next few weeks. I also confirmed that the date you were given originally was optimistic and assumed no delays. This new schedule is more realistic. Of course it is always possible that more problems could arise and delay it further, so I talked through the "worst case" scenarios with the Product team and it is agreed that late August accounts for a reasonable amount of delays. I will communicate with them regularly to see if the schedule can be improved, and also to be alerted if more problems arise; I'll communicate their progress back to you. We regret that this delay has happened and appreciate the importance of accurate information for you in the future.
- Warranty information: All radios are warranted for 1 year, and the warranty date starts at the time of programming and distribution. We will collect serial number information so our factory and your staff knows the warranty status of each radio.
